The International Student Program establishes a special relationship between two students, one from Chile and one from the United States. Through the ISP Program, these students are paired up and travel to each other's country, live with each other's family, and attend each other's school.

Additionally, with the exception of the plane ticket and the health insurance, all expenses to participate in the program (food, shelter, school supplies, others) are covered by each family as they host the foreign student. Thus, this unique partnership not only allows each student to see, experience, and learn a new culture, but it is also an easy and affordable way for families to financially partake in this opportunity.

As stated, each participating student is responsible for the cost of health insurance and the roundtrip plane ticket. The student is responsible for ensuring they have a valid **tourist** VISA and a valid passport prior to departure. Plane tickets and all travel arrangements, however, are coordinated by Saint George's College through an outside travel agency and payment is made to the respective travel agency accordingly.

Saint George students will have the opportunity to stay with an American student and his/her family for three weeks; the visit begins on January 24<sup>th</sup> and ends on February 17<sup>th</sup>.

Students are invited to apply if they meet the following criteria:

- 1. 6.0 average (I Semester 2018)
- 2. No subjects below 5.0 (I Semester 2018)
- 3. No conditional status (I Semester 2018)
